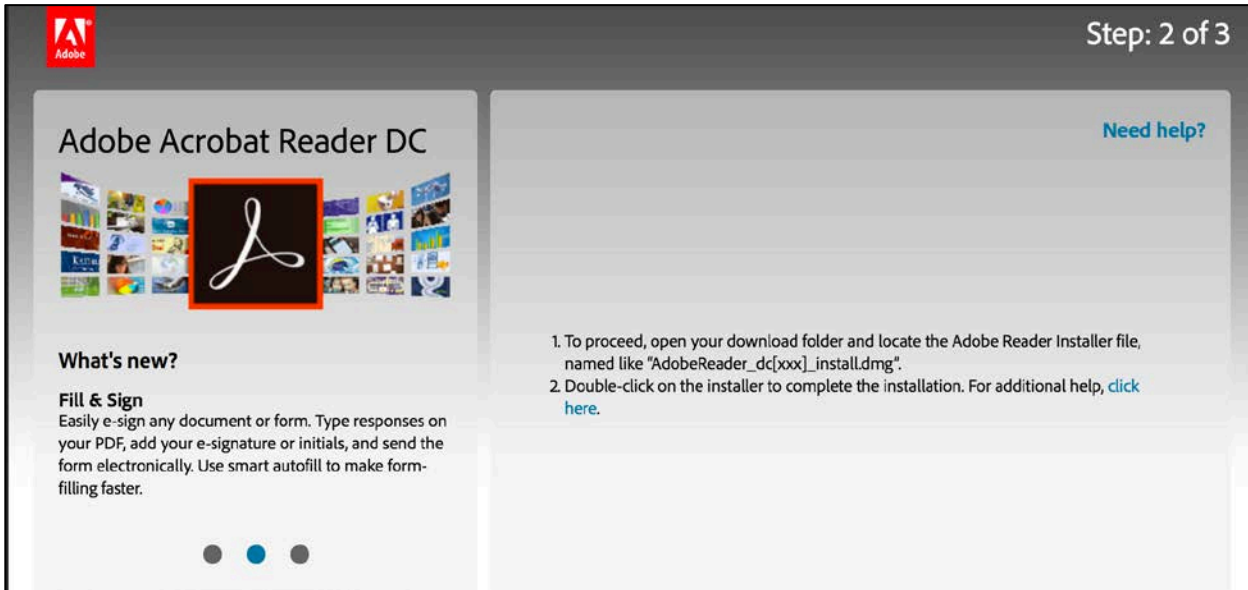
Click  to start the process.

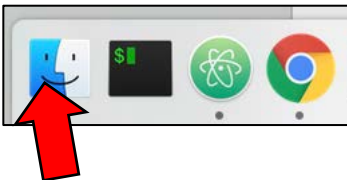
After the download is complete, instructions will be displayed requesting you find the downloaded Adobe Reader Installer file and double-click on it for installation.



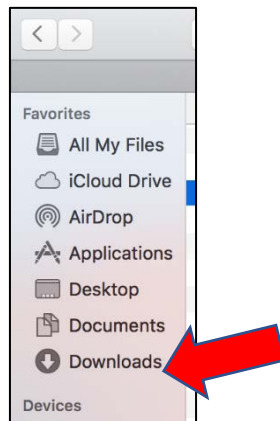
## LOCATING THE DOWNLOADED FILE ON AN APPLE COMPUTER

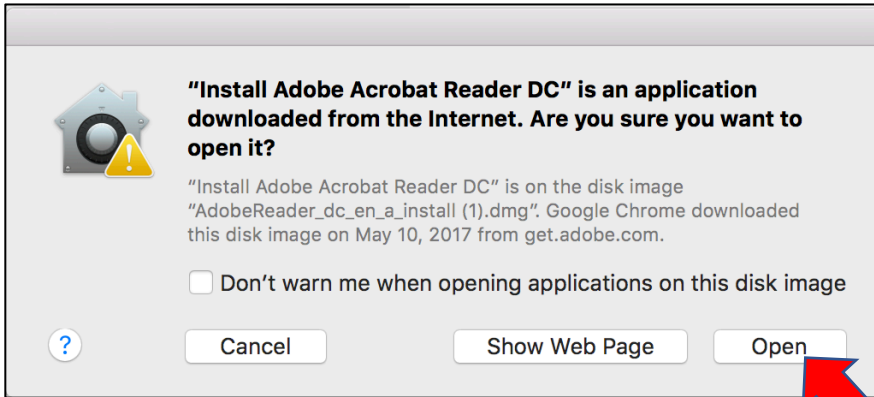

Step 3: Double-click on the downloaded file.

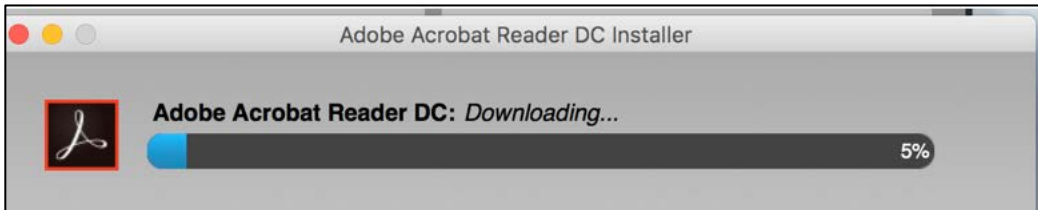


Double-click on "Install Adobe Acrobat Reader DC".

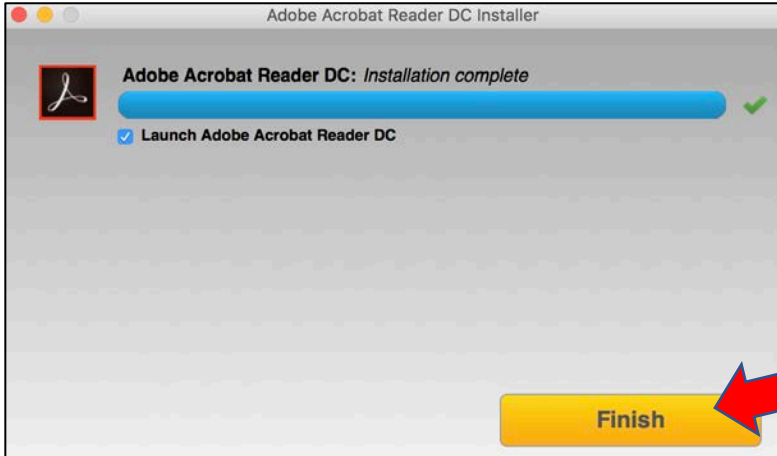


Click on the "Open" button.

Click the “Finish” button.

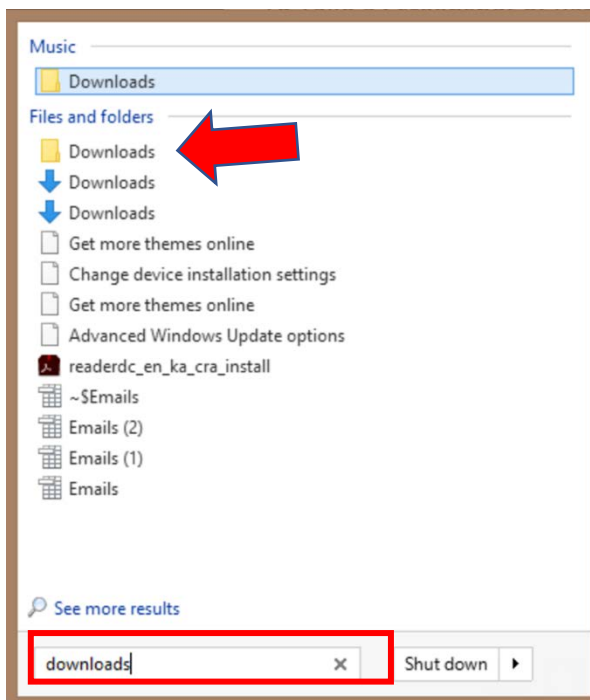


Adobe Acrobat is now installed!

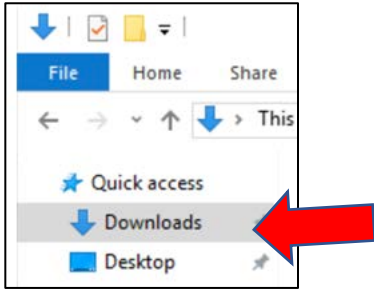

### **LOCATING THE DOWNLOADED FILE ON A WINDOWS COMPUTER**

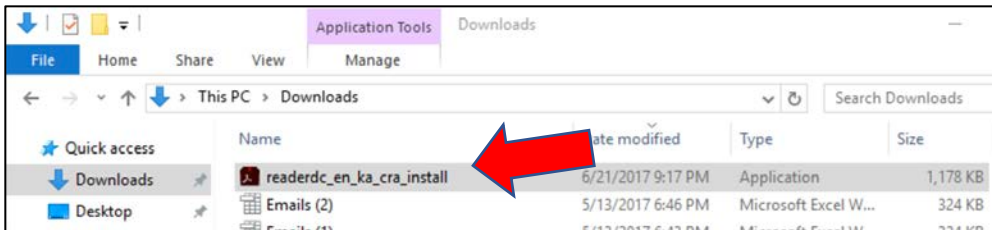
Windows users can do a search for “downloads” and double-click on the Downloads folder under Files and folders.



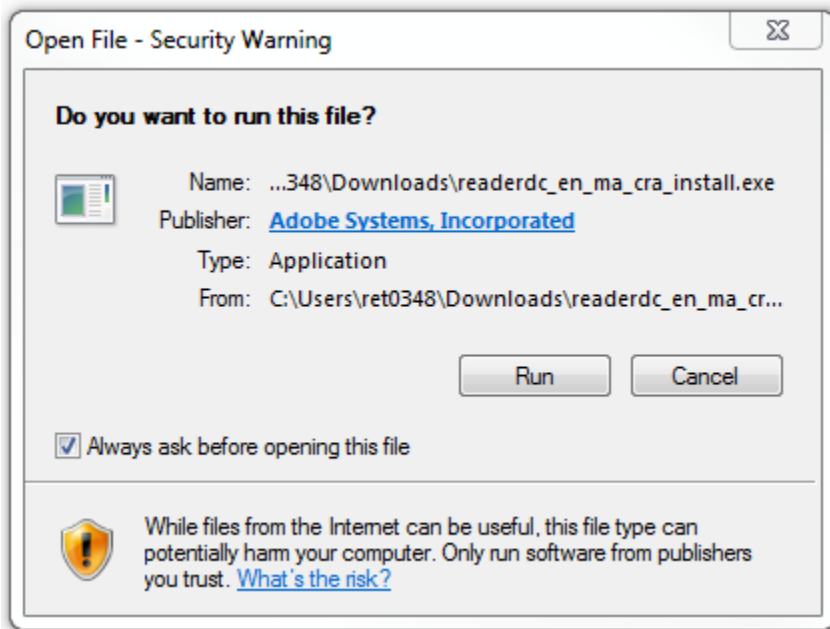
Click on "Downloads" in the left-hand, vertical toolbar to see the Adobe download.



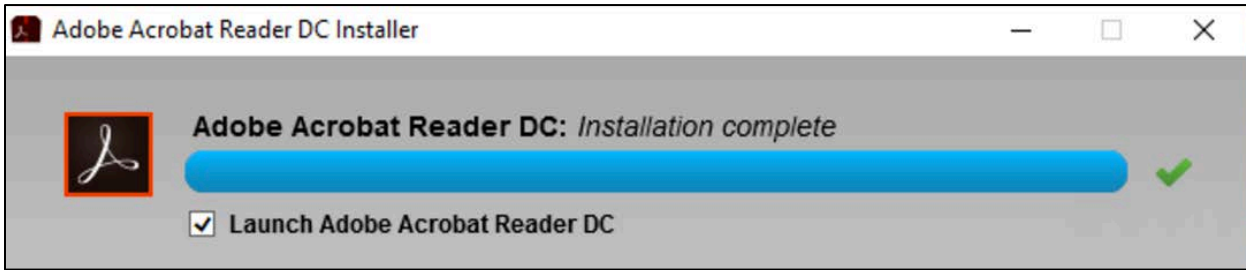
Double-click on the Adobe file.



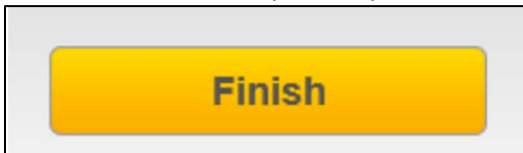
You may receive a pop up requesting confirmation that you want to open/run the file. Click the "Run" button.



Your computer will display the Adobe Acrobat installation status, alerting you when complete.



Once the install is complete, if you have a "Finish" button displayed, click it.
